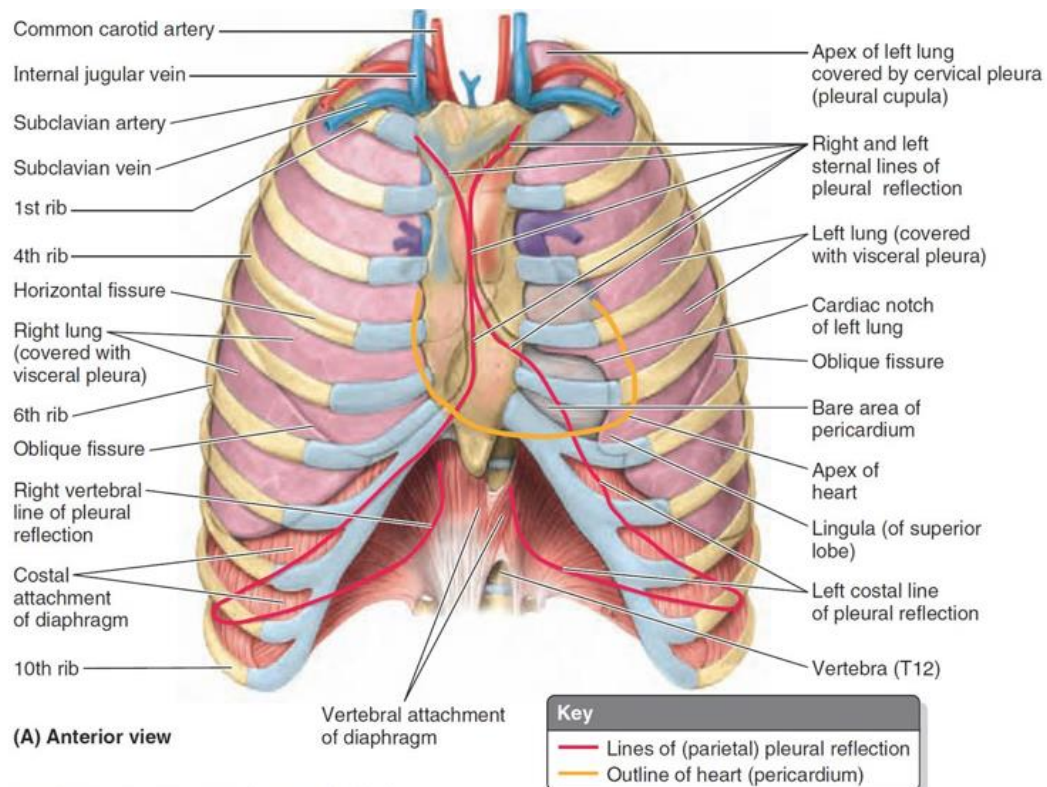
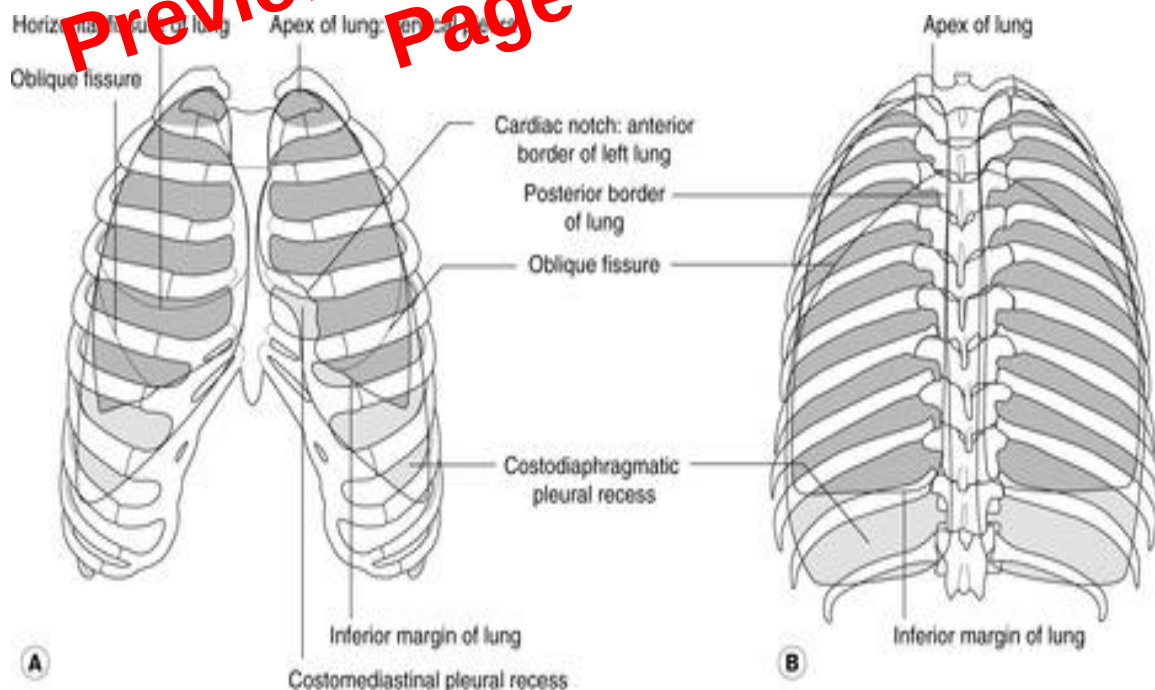

- Lungs do not fully occupy the pulmonary cavities; potential pleura space
 - Largest between the costal and diaphragmatic pleura known as the **costodiaphragmatic recesses**
 - Smaller space posterior to sternum – **costomediastinal recesses** – left recess is larger due to cardiac notch
