- Mental retardation and malformation
- Treatment of *T. pallidum* includes
 - **Penicillin**, being the drug of choice for this infection
 - This is ineffective against tertiary syphilis
 - Benzathine penicillin G or ceftriaxone must be used here
- o Prevention includes:
 - Sexual abstinence
 - Safe sex
 - No vaccine is currently available for T. pallidum
- o There are other Treonemal diseases caused by subspecies of *Treponema pallidum:*
 - T. pallidum endemicum Bejel
 - T. pallidum pertenue Yaws
 - T. carateum Pinta
 - These bacteria cause skin lesions and are transmitted through skin-skin contact
 - Penicillin can be used to treat these
