



## STEVEN HOGGETT

Steven Hoggett is now 45 years old and is a British choreographer and movement director, hence his role in the Frantic Assembly Company. He has won an Olivier Award and an Obie Award. He has also been nominated for Drama Desk Awards 4 times, and 3 times for a Tony Award.

Steven co-founded Frantic Assembly in 1994 at Swansea University with 2 of his peers. When he was younger and brought up near Huddersfield he participated in the Choral Society Young Choir and worked at Boots and a local restaurant. He had absolutely no experience in theatre and when studying literature at University, he challenged himself by creating a theatre company, unknowingly starting one of the most prestigious theatre companies in the UK to date.

The only experience in theatre Steven ever received was a workshop with Volcano Theatre Company. This was based in Swansea and occurred just months before he helped to develop his own Company based on theatre. Steven had no experience in theatre, but he had a desire to produce something different. Steven provided his own artistic and unusual choreographic flair to the company which won him awards in the future. Building up his experiences in small performances which he directed, produced and performed in, they started to attract attention. Soon Frantic Assembly were producing large scale tours and collaborating with some of the UK's biggest theatre companies.
