Lord of the Flies Quotes – Civilisation v Savagery

Civilisation

- ⇒ 'We can use this to call the others. Have a meeting' – Chapter 1. The boys are creating their own civilised community. They have meetings, leaders and an organised way of communication.
- ⇒ 'We've got to have rules and obey them. After all, we're not savages. We're English, and the English are best at everything' – Chapter 2. After just arriving on the island, the boys are still hopeful at keeping their civilisation and connection to their old life.
- ⇒ 'Here, invisible yet strong, was the taboo of the old life.' Chapter 4.
 In this quote, civilisation is holding Roger back from harming Henry.
- ⇒ 'So full of pride in his contribution to the good of society' – Chapter 8. Piggy wants to help within the community and create a better society.
- ⇒ 'Which is it for to have laws and part or to hunt and kilp - 3 S Chapter 11. Piggy is grasping at his

last chance to try and save the civilisation they once had.

Savagery

 \Rightarrow 'The madness came into his eyes again.

"I thought I might kill."' – Chapter 3. Jack is starting to show how much he wants to get lost in this new world of murder. He's starting to lose connection with his old life of civilisation.

- ⇒ 'Jack began to dance and his laughter became a bloodthirsty snarling.' – Chapter 4. This shows how much the island is beginning to get to him, as he starts to turn into a savaged animal.
- ⇒ "Kill the pig. Cut her throat. Bash her in." – Chapter 4. The hunters have created this chant, creating a tribe-like atmosphere. They are detaching themselves from their old war of a end become more

barbaric.

'Jack found the throat and the hot bood spouted over his hands.' – Chapter 8. The hunters are no longer hunting just for food, they are now doing it for the thrill, exercising their power over a helpless animal.

⇒ 'The boys screamed, struck, bit, tore. There were no words, and no movements but the tearing of teeth and claws.' – Chapter 9. The boys behave like animals as they murder Simon in a frenzy. They seem to have lost all sight of the old civilisation they once lived in, and all the morals that went with it.
