- 6. Sand the bookshelf with sandpaper to smooth out any rough edges or surfaces. If you're using a power sander, start with a coarse grit and work your way up to a finer grit.
- 7. If you want to stain or paint your bookshelf, apply that of wood stain or paint using a paintbrush or roller. Let it dry completely before adding additional Chars.
- 8. Once your bookshelf is dry, it's teach to use! Add your favorite books and decorations to themselves enjoy your new DIY creation.
