# ANTERIOR TRIANGLE OF THE NECK

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The anterior triangle of the neck is divided into four triangles surrounded by boundaries.

I. **S**ubmental Triangle

II. **D**igastric Triangle

III. **C**arotid Triangle

IV. **M**uscular Triangle

For easy remembrance use this mnemonic "**Sally's Dog Chased Mice.**"

# CLINICAL RELEVANCE

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Carotid pulsation

- Carotid bodies – important baroreceptors (sensors for changes in pressure)
- Carotid sinus hypersensitivity
- Ligation of external carotid artery
- surgical dissection of carotid Triangle
- Carotid occlusion and endarterectomy
