Know which drugs require a PPI and how often should you dispense it? - *CORRECT ANSWERS* • MDI's, Birth Control, Estrogens, Progesterones, Accutane, and IUD's.

- Must be dispensed every time.

What is the generic name of Accutane? What is the special warning? - *CORRECT ANSWERS* • Isotretinoin

- Will cause severe birth defects. Women of child bearing age must test negative to pregnancy before starting Accutane.

What medications can only be dispensed/stored in glass containers? -

CORRECT ANSWERS • Nitroglycerin (IV form and sublingual)

- Depakene liquid

Know a couple of IM medications - *CORRECT ANSWERS* • Depo-testosterone / Depo-Provera

- Phenergan (promethazine)
- Demerol (meperidine)
- Trimethobenzamide (Tigan)
- These medications require a long needle to reach the muscle under the skin. (1" or 1 1/2 ")

Know that SQ medications require *CORRECT ANSWERS* -very short needle. (5/8" or 1/2")

- Example is insulin
