New Haven and the safety

Firstly, I presented about the city, New Haven. It is the third biggest city in the state, Connecticut (also known as New England). The city had a population of 130 741 people in 2012. Secondly, I talked about the violent crime levels in New Haven and the student's safety at the campus. The violent crime levels vary dramatically between New Haven's neighborhoods. New Haven is the 18th most dangerous city in the United States. However, according to Yale University about their safety at the campus, they want us to believe that the students are safe with them. Yale assure us that the Yale University Police Department has everything under control.
