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Plant Growth Hormones.

human and plants both produce hormones to regulate their growth. Auxin and gibberellin are two plant growth hormones.

When a plant responds to a stimulus it is called tropism. A positive tropism is growing towards a stimulus and a negative tropism is growing away from a stimulus.
