

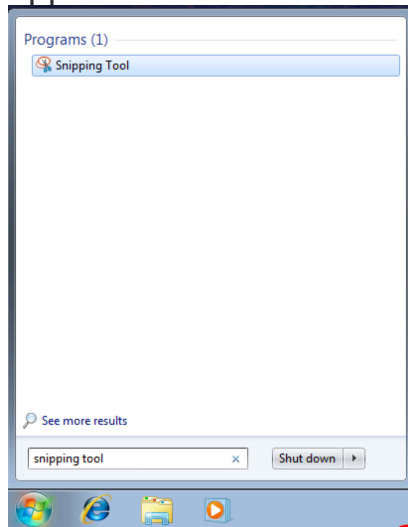
Windows 7 useful tips

This is a very useful 4 features is not in the windows XP

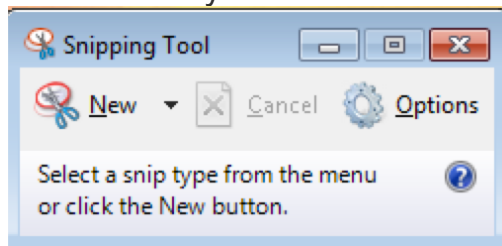
1- **the search box in the Start menu**

one of the most useful options in windows 7 as you can run, open or search for any file or program, you just need to write the name of the file or program you want to use and it will appear in the start menu.



2- **snipping tool**

in windows XP if you want to take a screen shot you need first to search for a screen shot button in the keyboard then press it then go to a photo editing program and past it on it then save it. Now all what you need is to open the snipping tool and take a screen shot you want



3- **access the secret "send too" Menu**

Did you know that there is a secret "Send To" menu that you can access with the Shift key? Hold down Shift, right-click the folder and select the "Send To" menu. This lets you access a whole new set of file locations.
