

throat to be swallowed and digested. Nicotine paralyses cilia so that mucus is unable to be waved to the throat.

Leaves are adapted to let light in because: the upper surface is transparent, palisade layer consists of chloroplasts that contain chlorophyll. Stomata have two guard cells. These cells consist of cellulose and open when the cell becomes turgid.
