RAPTUROUS

(ADJ)Feeling or expressing great pleasure or enthusiasm. Sentance: He was RAPTUROUS at the dinner table.

PLETHORA

(Noun)A large or excessive amount of something. Sentance: Donald Trump had a PLETHORA of money and hair spray.

MISER

(Noun)A person who hoards money and spends as little as possible. Sentance: Kevin was a MISER when he went on vacation.

DISPERSED

(Verb)To distribute or spread over a wide area. Sentance: Hillary Clinton DISPERSED her emails over multiple trash cans.
