- Fun fact- 1 in 400 babies are born with extra digits in US (higher frequency in Amish community)
- **Dominance-** When a dominant allele masks the expression of the recessive alleles in individuals with a heterozygous phenotype
  - o Only applies with complete dominance inheritance pattern
  - o Do NOT really discuss dominant alleles when discussing either incomplete dominance or codominance

- B) Law of Segregation
  - Law of Segregation- Separation of homologous chromosomes
    - Homologous chromosomes refer to those similar chromosomes with one from each parent
    - They separate during anaphase of meiosis 1 because meiosis eventually gives rise to haploid egg and sperm
