• Aqueous solution of 2.5-3% potassium dichromate for 24 hours to act as mordant for better staining effects

## Washing-out

- The process of removing excess fixative from the tissue after fixation in order to improve staining
- 1.tap water-is used to remove:
- 2.50-70% alcohol
- 3.alcoholic iodine

# Factors that affect fixation of tissues A.RETARDED BY:

- 1.size and thickness of the tissue specimen
- 2.presence of mucus
- 3.presence of fat
- 4.presence of blood

# Microwave technique

• Similar in mechanism to vacuum, oven (heat) and agitation to increase the movement of molecules and accelerate fixation
