"which I have not"

"I gave commands"

Domestic power, power of man, control

### Compares with:

Ozymandias, COTLB (misuse of power resulting in death)

#### **Context:**

Victoria vs Italian Renaissance

Attitudes to women = controlling

"taming a seahorse"
