Beta-Blockers - side effects

- Fatigue/sleep disturbance
- Bradycardia
- Hypotension
- Heart failure
- · Conduction disorders
- Bronchospasm
- Gl disturbances

Beta-Blockers - cautions and contraindications

- Asthma
- Uncontrolled heart failure
- Severe bradycardia
- Hypotension/shock
- AV block (2nd and 3rd degrees)
- Pheochromocytoma (unless with alpha blocker)
- Peripheral vascular disease

ension and decre Beta blockers reduce mortality in mild to moderate CHF - improve symptoms and decrease hospitalisation - benefit is not clear in Class I (mild) or class IV (severe)

Metoprolol

- Beta blocker
- Treats angina and
- Side effects
 - Lradycardia
 - Postural hypotension
 - SOB
 - Confusion
- Caution:
 - Other BP altering medicines

Spironolactone

- K+ sparing diuretic
- · Acts through active metabolite canrenone
- Blocks aldosterone receptors on the DCT (distal convoluted tubule)
- Taken with ACEi
- · Side effects:
 - Gynaecomastia (painful and irreversible)
 - Testicular atrophy
 - Menstrual irregularities
 - Hyperkalaemia (esp. renal impairment)
