

How did the Autoclave come to existence?

Similar to how we use autoclave now the Ancient Greeks had the same idea they used to use boil water to sterilize their medical tools. In the year of 1679 the famous French engineer designed the steam pressure cooker which would eventually lead to be a huge step In the evolution of steam engines. In the 1860s the French biologist Louis Pasteur affirms the germ hypothesis of illness. He understands that warming things to eliminate germs can avert illnesses and broaden the life of foodstuffs which drives him to the innovation of purification which became known as pasteurization. In the 1880s Pasteur's Partner Charles Chamberland invented the autoclave.
