Secondary Hypertension

- High blood pressure caused by another medical condition
- Can be caused by conditions affecting the kidneys, arteries, heart or endocrine system diabetes complications (*diabetic nephropathy*), *polycystic kidney disease* and *glomerular disease*. Can also occur in pregnancy
- Symptoms medication not reacting, sudden onset of high blood pressure before 30 or after 55
- Diagnosis ECG, urinalysis, blood tests, kidney ultrasound
- Treatment β -blockers, *thiazide diuretics*
