TDA35-4.3 Use appropriate strategies for encouraging and supporting children and young people to understand and respect other people:

- Individuality, diversity and differences
- Feelings and points of view.

It is important for children to learn to understand and respect the feelings of others. Children who are younger will find this difficult as the will not understand to put themselves in the position as others. In school we try to make children understand how to consider others feelings through stories and assemblies.

Effective ways of encouraging children to understand and respect others feelings is through discussions and activities such as circle time. This will help children to listen and wait for them turn to speak.

Children will also need to understand how their own feelings might affect their behaviour and we need to talk to them about this. E.g. I know you are upset but you will not be playing with the toys today.

This will help them understand the link between emotion and behaviour.
