eyes are described as burning with "a cruel apocalyptic light" and how there rage is said to be "blind" which has similarities to how God is meant to be judge you without prejudice.

The poem ends with sadness as this memory fades from the narrators mind and leaves him only with bland reality. This shows how in memory the most mundane of things can be transformed into a biblical thing of greatness.
