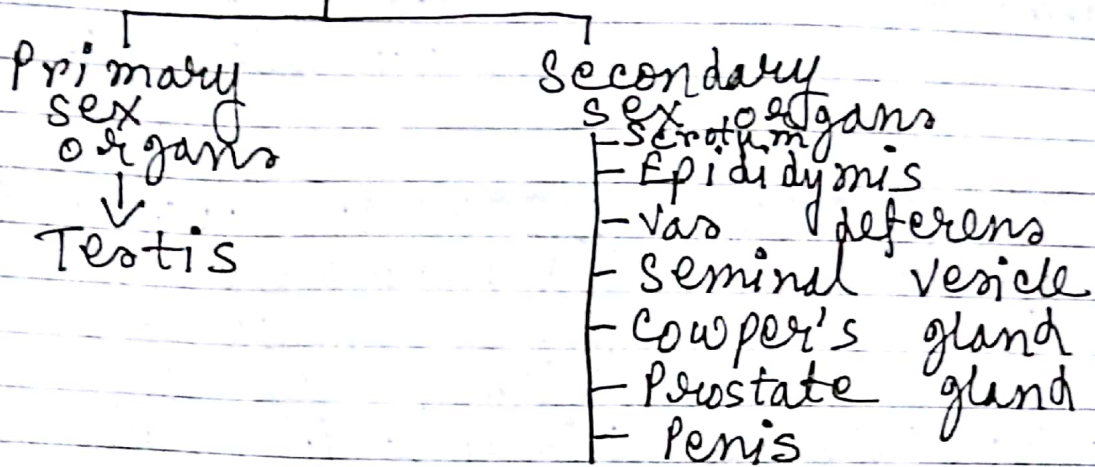


- Reproductive system - The system consists of organs which has the capacity to produce other organism of same kind is called Reproductive system.
- MALE REPRODUCTIVE SYSTEM -



<u>Parts</u>	<u>Function</u>
a) Testis - flattened oval organ, another name male gonad	i) secretes testosterone ii) produces sperm
b) Scrotum - sac like structure	i) maintains constant temp in testis
c) Epididymis - coiled structure	i) serves to suspend the testis within scrotum
d) Vas deferens - contains a short duct called ejaculatory duct	i) acts as storehouse and passage of sperm
e) Seminal Vesicles - paired pouch like glands	i) secrete a viscous fluid
f) Cowper's gland - another name is Bulbo-urethral gland	i) discharge a slimy mucoid secretion
g) Prostate gland -	i) secretes an alkaline fluid called prostatic
h) Penis - external genital organ
