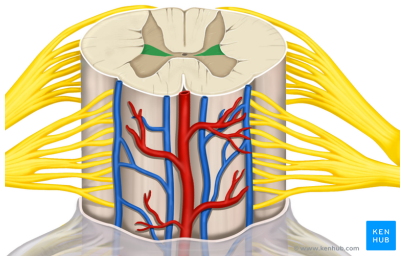
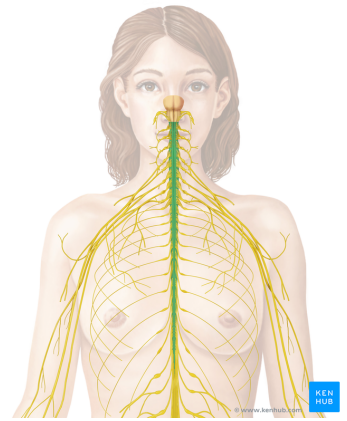


// SYMPATHETIC CHAINS //

- Sympathetic pathway = preganglionic, ganglionic, post ganglionic
- Preganglionic neurones are in the spinal cord and their fibres (axons/ preganglionic fibres)
- Preganglionic fibres leave spinal cord and travel through the anterior rami of spinal nerves to the sympathetic trunks via white rami communicantes
 - T1-6 innervate the head, upper limb and thoracic viscera
 - T7-11 innervate body wall and abdominal viscera
 - T11- L3 innervate the lower limb and pelvic viscera



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
