

• Residency - many states require that citizens reside in a state for a certain number of days before an election to be eligible to vote.

• absentee ballots - special ballots for state residents who are away from home or ill. These are mailed to voters, then returned by mail. Voters must apply for these ballots prior to an election.

• Voters must register with their local election board to be eligible to vote. Registration forms are available in government offices or obtained from an election board prior to completion.

• ballot fraud - a person casting multiple votes using false identification.

• How do voters cast their choices in an election?

• Ballot - anything voters mark or manipulate in order to make their election choices known.

• ballot box - a box paper ballots are dropped in.

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
