

Drugs causing Xerostomia

- Anticonvulsants
- Antidepressants
- Antianxiety agents
- Antihistamines
- Diuretics
- Narcotics
- Sedatives
- Tranquilizers

Control of Salivation

- **Acetyl Coline**- allows for lots of saliva
- **Anticholinergic Drug**- Inhibits Acetyl Choline

Vomiting Induced By

- Overstretching of stomach/Duodenum
- Chemical irritants
- Visceral Trauma
- Intense pain

Peristalsis- Oesophagus; Oral Cavity to Stomach

Segmentation- Stomach and Small Intestine

Metabolic Acidosis- Suppresses Medulla Oblongata (Controls breathing and heartrate)

Valsalva Maneuver- Causes abdominal collapse
