Personal A

Usage

Used when the direct object (the noun or pronoun that receives the action of the verb) is a person or a domesticated animal that someone feels an attachment to. It is not used after 'tener' or the verb form 'hay'. It is also not used if the direct object is an indefinite person (such as needing **a** doctor).

Examples

Jorge llama **a** María - Jorge calls María La mujer acaricia **a** su perro - the woman pets her dog (acariciar) El perro persigue **a** la gata - the dog chases the cat (perseguir)
