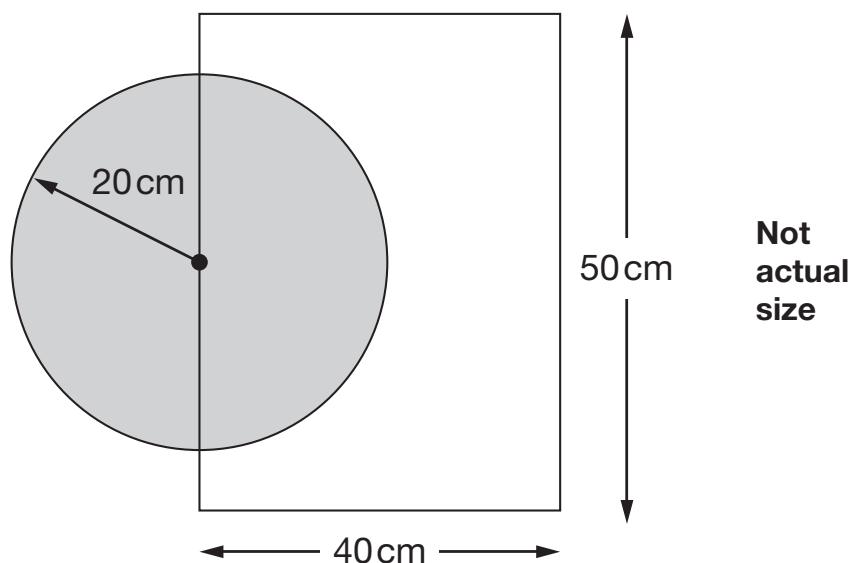


The diagram shows a rectangle and a shaded circle with radius 20 cm.
