Characteristics of the cartoon

- \checkmark Visualized story of a chronological sequence that needs many frames.
- \checkmark Describe the various situations in which the protagonists are engaged.
- \checkmark Follow the structure of a story or novel.
- \checkmark Composed by the integration of verbal and iconic elements.
- ✓ Its intrigue or plot can last months or years, since it is usually read at intervals, if it has a periodic continuation, although it can also appear in a single publication.
- ✓ It has more extensive narrative and dialogue elements, that is, verbal and iconic elements that are integrated into the pictographic unit, called a vignette or picture, which is related to the other cartoons of the comic strip.
- ✓ They can be mythological, historical, political, science fiction, romantic, et cetera.
- ✓ Approaches what might be called literary visualization.
