Where were the key events of henry viii's reign?

1520-29:

1520: henry met Francis of France near Calais at the field of cloth of gold, a great diplomatic event that seemed to show off henrys power.

1521: the pope gave henry the title 'defender of the faith' for writing a book criticising the pope and the catholic church against criticism by martin Luther, a German priest.

1522-25:war with France. Nothing was achieved, a great expense.

1525: the amicable grant rising: a rebellion in east Anglia caused by high taxes.

1526-9: henry wanted to end his marriage to Catherine so he could marry Anne Boleyn. All efforts to persuade the pope to grant an annulment failed

1528: henry declared war on emperor Charles v of Germany, but no war was fought.

1529: wosely fell from power over his failure to persuade the poor to

annulment of henrys marriage to Catherine of Aragonal Grey died on his way to stand trial for treason.
