

Act 4 – Scene 1: The Witches tell Macbeth to beware of Macduff, but he is relieved to hear that he cannot be defeated by anyone of 'woman born' and even then, not unless Birnam Wood moves to Dunsinane.

Act 4 – Scene 2: Macbeth has Lady Macduff, her family and her servants slaughtered.

Act 4 – Scene 3: Macduff visits Malcolm in England and persuades him to return to Scotland with an army to overthrow Macbeth

Act 5 – Scene 1: Watched by her servant and a doctor, Lady Macbeth sleepwalks in a state of anxiety. The doctor tells the servant to look after her.

Act 5 – Scene 2 & 3: The English/Scottish army approaches and Macbeth get ready to defend his castle

Act 5 – Scene 4: in Birnam Wood Malcolm orders soldiers to cut branches to use as camouflage

Act 5 – Scene 5: Lady Macbeth dies – apparently by suicide – and Macbeth is dismayed to hear that a wood is approaching

Act 5 – Scene 6 & 7: The armies attack Macbeth's castle. Macbeth kills Young Siward, but his armies surrender.

Act 5 – Scene 8: Macduff fights Macbeth. He kills Macbeth that he wasn't born, but cut from his mother. Macbeth realises he's beaten, but fights on.

Act 5 – Scene 9: Macduff arrives with Macbeth's severed head and hails Malcolm as king of Scotland. Malcolm promises to reward those who deserve reward.

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
