HOW TO GIVE EIRSPAND TO A VICTIM OF SCORPION BITE • Apply Pourniquet • Purtice

- Put ice on the injured area to relieve pain and prevent spread of the poison
- Treat for shock
- Rush the person to the hospital

HOW TO HELP A VICTIM OF DOG BITE Notes and 102 Wash year hands well with soap and water

- Wash the wound thoroughly with soap and water to remove the animal's saliva using running water.
- Cover the wound with clean gauze.
- Bandage it carefully
- Take the victim to the hospital

6. BONE FRACTURE

 - Fainting or shock

POSSIBLE CAUSES OF VOMITING Notes and 102 • Affergic Reactions

- Diseases e.g. malaria
- Physiological condition e.g. pregnancy
- Food poisoning
- Unpleasant smell or taste
- Drinking a lot of water when thirsty.

- TREATMENT OF MUSCLE CRAMPS
 Notes and 102

 Straighter the victim's knee and draw his/her foot firmly and steady upwards towards the shin
- Massage the muscles while stretching the limb until the cramping has reduced
- Apply some anti-cramp ointment to the affected area
- Give a glass of water if there is lack of water in the victim's body
- Seek medical help if the cramps do not stop

SIGNS AMOUSYMPTOMS OF SHOCK Notes at 102 Mental confusion

- Weakness or loss of consciousness
- Blood pressure drops drastically low
- Cold, sweat, cold dump skin
- Weak and rapid pulse

- Bad news. E.g. death of a loved one
- •Unpleasant sight. E.g. the sight of a snake or lion
- Illness
- Shock
- Excessive bleeding

- Shouting for help from the victim
- Abrupt or violent movement from the victim. E.g. splashing of water, waving of hands, etc

• Raw sewage should be treated before

- emptying it into the water bodies.
- When handling wastes, precautions should be observed. E.g. gloves, gas masks and other protective gears must be used.
- Sewage system must be checked and monitored regularly. E.g. controlling leakage
