Chorea is mainly involvemented.

- characterized by rapid, irregular involuntary movements of short duration.
- Athetosis is due to lesion of the lenticular nucleus and is characterized by continuous, slow twisting movement.
- > Huntingson's disease : It is an autosomal dominant inherited disorder. It is due to damage of GABA-ergic and cholinergic neurons that project to putamen, resulting in hyperkinetic features:
