- Always start your start by introducing yourself: 'Hello, my name is... and I am a medical student at University. I have been asked by your doctor to do a specific examination for you.
- >Wash your hands.
- Check the patient's identity before explaining the procedure to make sure you have your right patient.
- Always give your patients enough information in a way they that they can understand so then they give you informed consent to perform the examination.
- > Reassure your patients that their information and the examination results will be kept confidential.
- > Ask about pain. Also tell them to stop you if they feel pain through out the procedure.
- ➤ Make sure you clean your stethoscope with alcohol wipes.
