

Punnet squares

- Are one way of showing all the possible types of offspring that could result from a cross.
- It represents a probability.
- Genotype shows actual genetic information carried by an individual
- Phenotype shows observable characteristics or traits of the individual.

Eg:

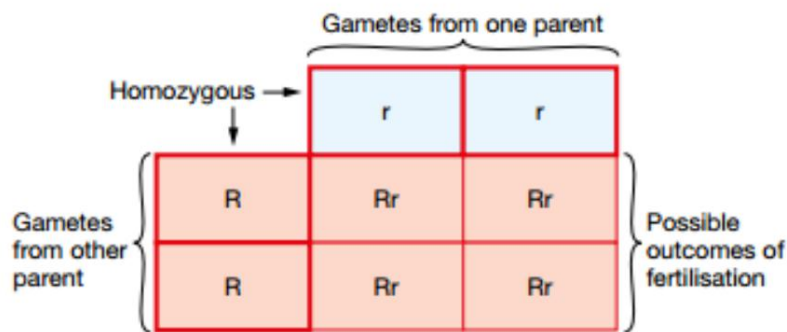


FIGURE 2.4.4 This Punnett square shows the possible outcomes of a cross between two homozygous individuals.
