

56. Other name anti-anxiety drugs

**-Anxiolytics**

57. Anti-anxiety drug which acts on the 5-HT<sub>1A</sub> serotonin receptor subtype

**-Buspirone**

58. Group of mental conditions that includes depression, bipolar syndrome, and several others that are characterized by a marked disturbance in patient's mood **-Affective disorders**

59. Depression is believed to be initiated by pre and postsynaptic receptor **-Down regulation**

66. Psychosis is the term used to describe the more severe forms of mental disorders. The most common form **-schizophrenia**

67. A diagnosis of schizophrenia can be given provided that the marked disturbance in thought process lasted **-6 months**

68. Extrapyramidal symptom that refers to inability to sit still, with feelings of restlessness and urge to move about **-Akathisia**

69. Conglomeration of involuntary movements including protrusion of tongue, chewing movements, and puffing of cheeks **-tardive dyskinesia**

70. Extrapyramidal symptom can be life threatening and is manifested by febrile episodes, coma, catatonia, rigidity, tremors

71. Extrapyramidal condition refers to a group of signs and symptoms such as facial grimacing, torticollis, and involuntary muscle spasms **-dystonia**
