

What is a logical term? It is a word that names or gives extraordinary data about a design or interaction. Some logical terms have a few unique parts. These parts are known as a PREFIX, a ROOT (or base), and a SUFFIX. A model is the word subcutaneous.

SUBCUTANEOUS means underneath the skin. SUB means underneath. SUB is the prefix. CUTIS implies skin. CUTIS is the root.

A subsequent model is the word myocardium.

MYOCARDIUM implies the solid mass of the heart. MYO implies muscle. MYO is a prefix.

CARDIUM implies heart. CARDIUM is the root.

A third model is the word tonsillitis.

TONSIL is the root

ITIS is the addition and means irritation.

So, TONSILLITIS implies irritation of the tonsils

THE ANATOMICAL POSITION

The physical position is a fake stance of the human body (see figure 1-2). This position is utilized as a standard reference all through the clinical calling.

We generally talk about the pieces of the body as though the body were in the physical position. This is valid paying little heed to what position the body is in reality in. In the physical

position, the body stands erect, with heels together. Upper individuals are along the
