The wheel network has a central leader. There is little or no communication between the 'spokes'. In this structure, leader controls the line of communication and ensures that messages are passed efficiently.

The Y network – here information from the leader is shared at the same time through two channels who pass on the information outwards. This structure ca spread information faster than the chain.

Effective communication: the successful exchange of information between people or groups, preferably with feedback.
