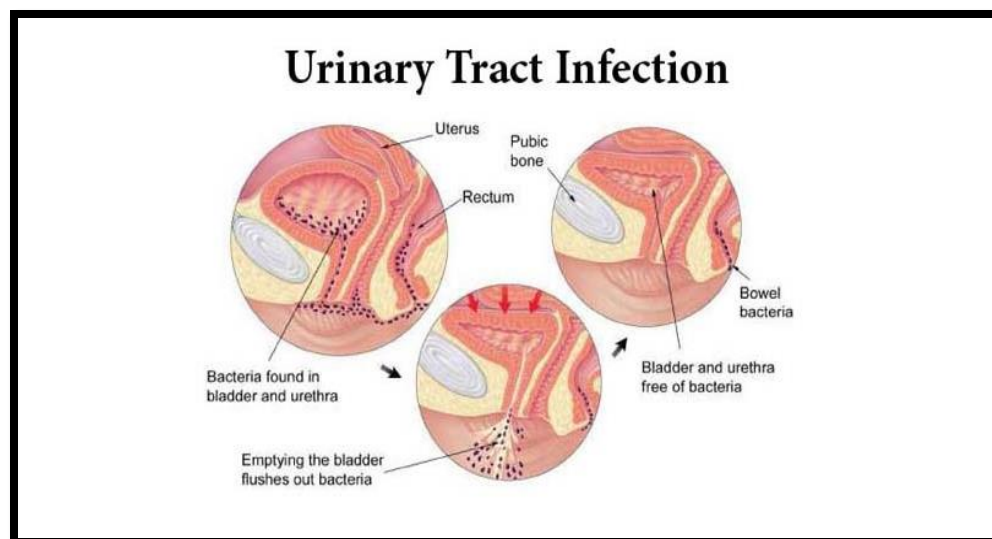




In the children fever is the most common symptom have observed but the fatigue is common symptom in the elders.

UTI's are arise when various types of microbes enter into the urinary tract and can cause infections. Uropathogenic *E. coli* from the gut is the main cause of about 80-85% of the UTI's and the *Staphylococcus saprophyticus* is also the cause of about 15-10%.
