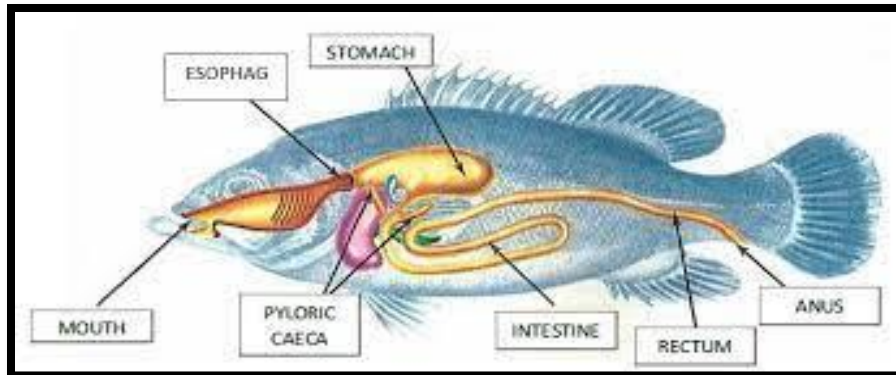




- **Stomach of amphibians;** In the buccal cavity of frogs, the stomach is located on the left side that is associated with the dorsal body-wall via the mesentery or layer known as the mesogaster. The stomach is curved tube and also with broad muscular walls that is about four cm in length. Cardiac stomach is the anterior region that is also large. The pyloric stomach is also small that is the posterior region or part. Inside the stomach many longitudinal layers are also found.

Some glands release the HCL which are helpful in digestion. So, the stomach of amphibians like as frog is helpful in digestion of the food components and additionally it is also work as storage.
