① Difference: Romans & Greek Tragic Heroes

- Greeks •
  - comes from nobility
  - eminently good but not perfect w/ single blotish (pride, harshness brought one's downfall)
  - Aversion of Fortune
  - has the tragic grandeur (capacity to suffer excruciatingly but still a man to emulate)
- Romans •
  - from noble birth
  - eminently good but not perfect
  - experiences an unpleasant metamorphosis from good to worst. (not so pathetic)

Supers in silence; prepared to face the consequences however he openly laments his fate; a noisy sufferer; knew about his sufferings

to were not so original with tragedy but with comedy. They were able to introduce dramaturgy.
