

- faecal-oral route - replication in intestine
- watery diarrhoea - dehydration follows
- no specific treatment
 - restore fluids/electrolytes
- live attenuated vaccine - oral
- common side effects
 - fever, diarrhoea, vomiting

tetanus

- caused by toxin
- spores are widespread in the environment
- neurotoxin produce in the absence of O₂
- symptoms
 - muscle spasms
 - seizure-like activity
 - respiratory muscles paralysed
 - death (almost always)
- common in newborns
- booster immunisation every 10 years

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
