

than biologically, because it is the role and status associated with men and women which bring these differences in their language.

A study conducted by GEORGE KEITH “LIVING LANGUAGE” where he points out the following differences between men and women’s language.

According to him, women talk more than men, talk more polite, are indecisive/ hesitant, complain and, ask more questions, support each other, and are more cooperative than men. Men, in contrary, swear more, don’t talk about emotion, talk about sport more, talk about women and machine in the same way, insult each other frequently, are competitive in conversation, dominate conversation, speak with more authority, give more commands and interpret more.

D. PETER TRUDGILL “Gender and Speech Sound” in 1970

Trudgill investigated the differences between men and women speech sound and concluded that women use hyper-correct pronunciation. They pronounce the /g/ sound in the words ending with ‘ing’ while men usually drop the /g/ sound in their speech. **E. Jennifer Coates and Deborah Jones.**

J. Coates and Jones investigated all female conversation based on Tannen and Lakoff’s theory.

They mention four characteristics of women’s speech. Which are as follows

1. House talk

Women talk mainly about household and their work place.

2. Scandal

They mostly talk about other women

3. Bitching

They always make complain about the place and situation they are living in.

4. Chatting

They share their feeling emotion and personal stories.
