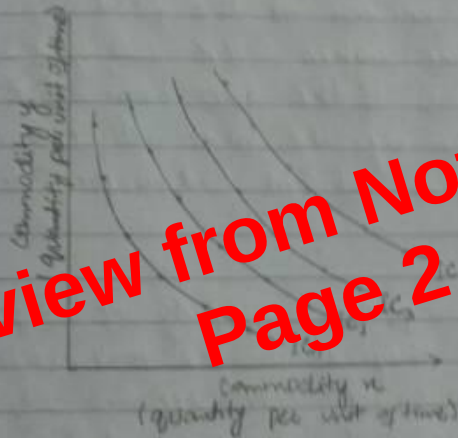


Question no. 1

(a) The indifference map is the graphical representation of two or more indifference curves showing the level combination of different quantities of commodities, which consumer consumes, given his income and the market price of goods and service.



The right hand side curve on an indifference map gives more utility than the left hand side because right hand side gives the large quantities of goods than the left hand curve gives the lower quantity of goods.
