

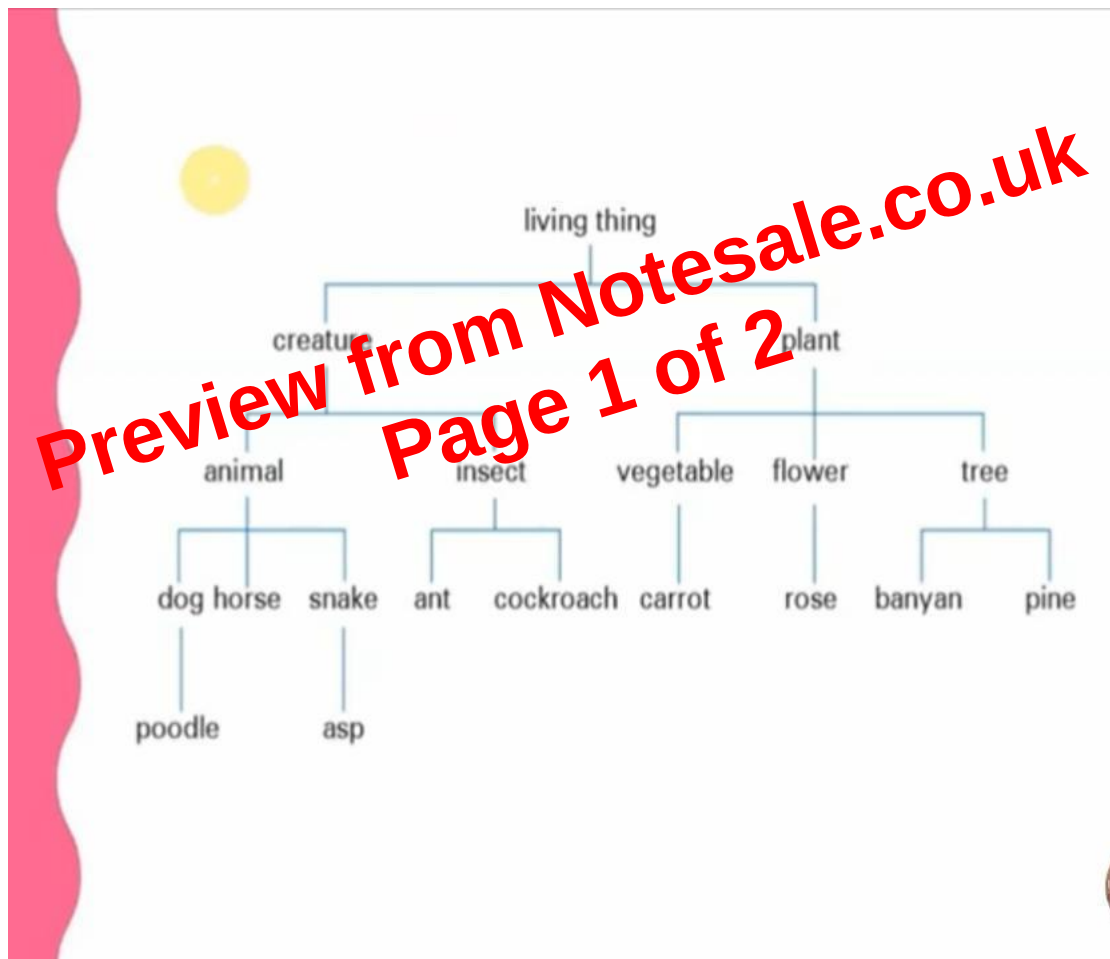
Hyponymy

When the meaning of one form is included in the meaning of another, this relationship is described as hyponym.

hyponym is a phrase whose semantic field is included within that of another word, its hypernym. Hypernym are also called generic terms or superordinates.

For example

- 1) The phrase Red is a color can be used to describe the hyponymic relationship between red and color.
- 2) Horse is the hyponym of animal
- 3) Tomato is the hyponym of vegetable Etc
