5 → What is the procedure for the appointment of the chief Election Commissioner in India?

- Ans 5) 1) The chief Election Commissioner (CEC) is appointed by the President of India.
- 2) But once appointed, CEC is not answerable to the President or the government.
  - 3) Even if the ruling party of the govt. does not like what the Commissioner does, it is virtually impossible to remove the CEC.
  - 4) The CEC has tenure of 6 years or up to the age of 65 years.
  - 5) The status, salary and perks of the CEC are taken to the judges of the Supreme Court.
  - 6) The CEC can be removed from office only through impeachment of it by the parliament.
