- 1. Consistent, proactive discipline is the core of effective classroom management.
- 2. Establish routines for all daily tasks and needs.
- 3. Orchestrate smooth transitions and continuity of momentum throughout the day.
- 4. Strike a balance between variety and challenge in student's activities
- 5. As classroom manager, be aware of all actions and activities in the classroom.
- 6. Resolve minor inattention and disruption before they become major disruptions.
- 7. Reinforce positive behavior.
 - a. **Subtraction mentality** these are the type of teachers who think less when they praise
 - b. **Overgenerous** praises overflow that they give praises even when it is not appropriate.
- 8. Treat minor disturbance calmly.
