

Principles in Classroom Management

1. Consistent, proactive discipline is the core of effective classroom management.
2. Establish routines for all daily tasks and needs.
3. Orchestrate smooth transitions and continuity of momentum throughout the day.
4. Strike a balance between variety and challenge in student's activities
5. As classroom manager, be aware of all actions and activities in the classroom.
6. Resolve minor inattention and disruption before they become major disruptions.
7. **Reinforce positive behavior.**
 - a. **Subtraction mentality** – these are the type of teachers who think less when they praise
 - b. **Overgenerous**- praises overflow that they give praises even when it is not appropriate.
8. Treat minor disturbance calmly.
9. Work out a physical arrangement of chairs that facilitates an interactive teaching-learning process.
10. Make good use of every instructional moment. Minimize discipline time to maximize instructional time.

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
