HTML also defines special elements for defining text with special meaning. HTML uses elements like <b> and <i> for formatting output, like bold or italic text. Formatting elements were designed to display special types of text:

## HTML TEXT FORMATTING

### HTML <b> and <strong> Elements

The HTML **<b>** element defines **bold** text, without any extra importance.

Example:

<b>This is bold</b>

The HTML **<strong>** element defines **strong** text, with added semantic "strong" importance.

Example:

#### <i>This is italic</i>

The HTML **<em>** element defines emphasized text, with added semantic importance.
