Helping Verbs

Use of “a” or “an”:

a We use ‘a’ before singular noun begun with a consonant. For example a bag, a cat, a flag etc.

an We use ‘an’ before singular noun begun with a vowel. For example an apple, an arm, an owl etc.

Use of “This” or “These”:

This “This” is used in the sentence to point out something singular which is near.

These “These” is used in the sentence to point out something plural which is near.

Use of “That” or “Those”:

That “That” is used in the sentence to point out something singular which is far.

Those “Those” is used in the sentence to point out something plural which is far.
