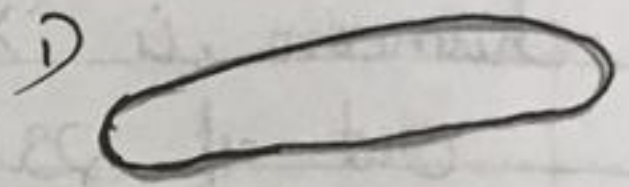
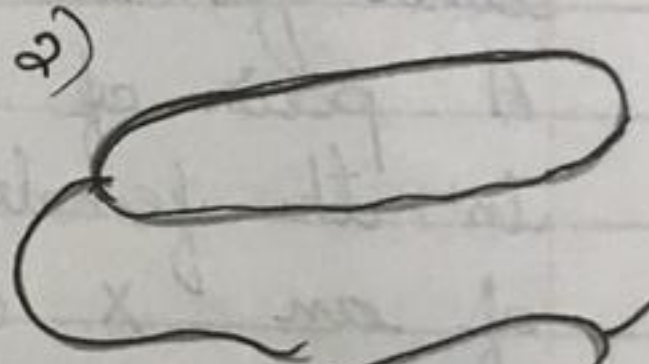


Types of flagellar arrangement in bacteria

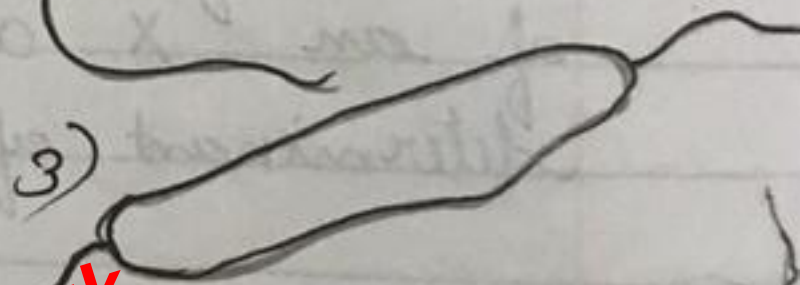
1) Atrichous

(one flagella)
single



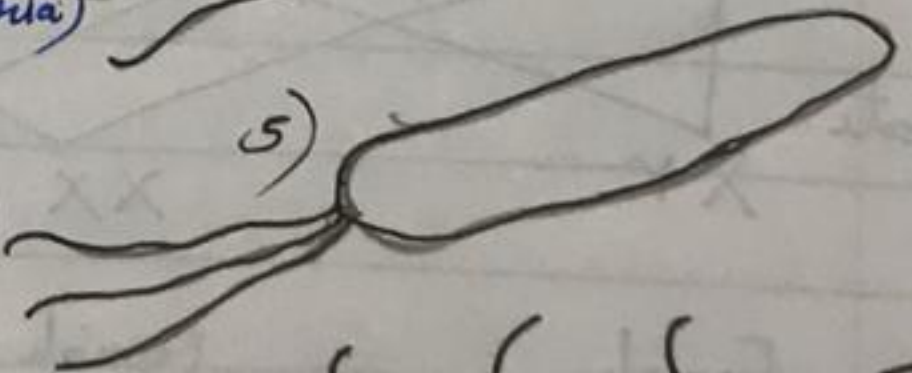
3) Amphitrichous
(A single flagellum
at each end of the cell)



4) Cephalotrichous
(2 or more flagella
attached at one
end of the bacteria)

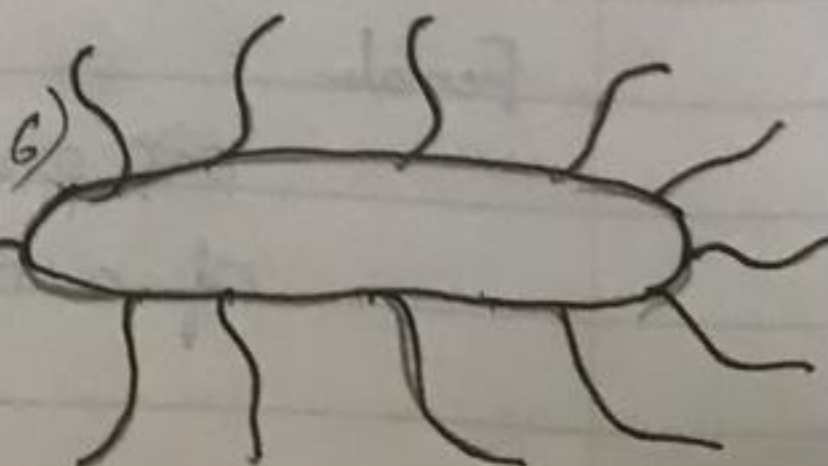


5. Lophotrichous
(Multiple flagella)
located at the
same spot



6. Peritrichous

(flagella ~~at~~ uniformly
distributed over the
body)
