

Porifera (Lt. *porus* = pore, *ferre* = to bear)

General characteristics

1. They are extremely aquatic; live a sedentary & sessile life.
2. Body is full of pores. Mainly 2 types of pores are found - ostia, osculum.
3. First diploblastic animal, cellular organisation found in body.
4. Different types of unique cells are found in body. such as choanocytes, pinoocytes etc.
5. Water canal system is found in this phylum
6. Internal skeletal system made up of spicules calcaceous or siliceous and spongin fibres.
7. Carries a central body cavity called spongocoel.
8. They are monocious. Reproduce through sexual & asexual both methods.
e.g.: Scypha, Spongilla etc.
